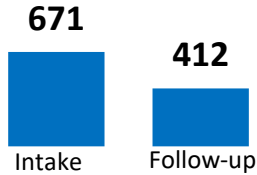
TRIBAL TREATMENT AND RECOVERY INITIATIVE (STR-TOTR)

INTER-TRIBAL COUNCIL OF MICHIGAN

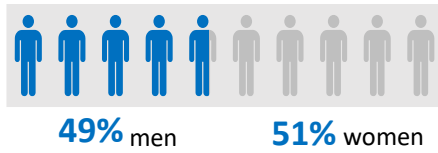
The Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan, Anishnaabek Healing Circle Tribal Treatment and Recovery Initiative (STR-TOTR) provided evidence-based and culturally responsive substance abuse treatment and recovery support services for uninsured and underinsured American Indians with an opioid use diagnosis. Participants were 12 and older and resided within the service area of one of the twelve federally recognized tribes in Michigan. The program operated from 7-1-17 thru 4-30-20.

CLIENTS SERVED THROUGH ANISHNAABEK HEALING CIRCLE STR-TOTR SERVICES

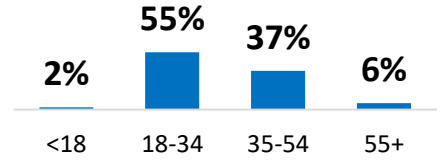
Out of **671** intakes, **61.0%** completed a **6-month follow-up**.

OF THOSE WHO HAVE EXPERIENCED ANY VIOLENCE OR TRAUMA

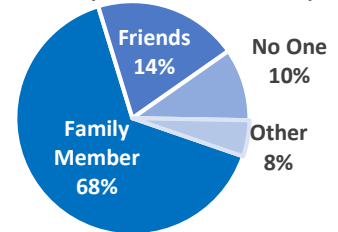
70% felt numb or detached

77% tried not to think about violence or trauma

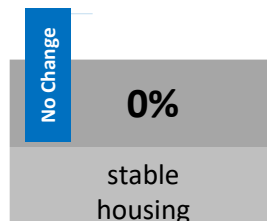
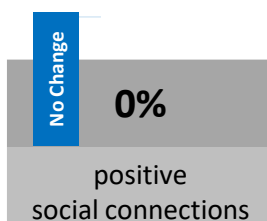
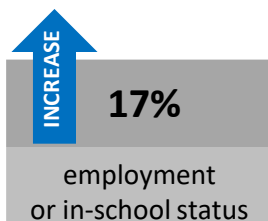
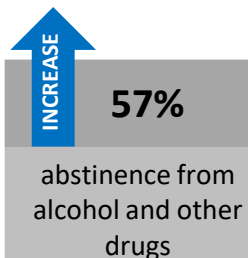
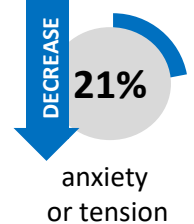
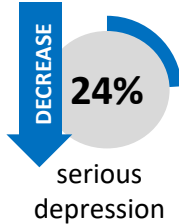
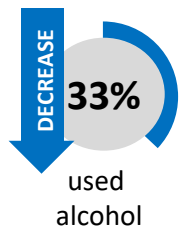
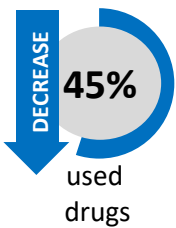
72% constantly on guard
